



The Paul Foot Award for Campaigning Journalism 2008

Now in its fourth year and sponsored by the *Guardian* and *Private Eye*, **The Paul Foot Award** honours campaigning journalism in the UK, in memory of revered investigative journalist Paul Foot, who died in 2004, aged 66.

Submissions will be accepted for material that has been published in a newspaper, magazine or online between 1st September 2007 and 31st August 2008. No broadcast material is eligible.

Individual journalists, teams of journalists or entire publications may enter and entries will be considered for anything from single pieces to entire campaigns.

The overall winner will be awarded **£5000**, with the five runners up each receiving **£1000**, at a ceremony to be held in London on Monday 3rd November 2008.

The closing date for entries is 1st September 2008
